2. The Swimming Victoria 11 years and under race suit rule will be enforced at this meet.
3. All events will be swum as timed finals, with heats seeded slowest to fastest. Bayside Swimming Club reserves the right to cancel, combine or alter any event.
4. Registered Swimming Victoria swimmers only to apply via Swim Central (or interstate equivalent), age as at 18 July 2026.
5. Entry fee, \$15 per event. Entries via Swim Central only (Includes Swimming Victoria levy for approved meet administration).
6. Online entries close 11.59pm Sunday 12 July 2026 or prior if capacity is reached.
7. Refund of entry fees will only be provided via Swim Central if approved. Refunds will not be given for any withdrawals.
8. Free admission for swimmers and spectators.
9. Medals will be awarded for all 50m events and the 100IM for the 9& Under, 10, 11 and 12 age groups.
